

BYLAW NUMBER 1383A

BYLAW NUMBER 1383A OF THE TOWN OF INNISFAIL, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, BEING A BYLAW TO REPEAL BYLAW 1368, BEING AN AMENDMENT TO THE TRAFFIC BYLAW, AND BEING REPLACED BY THIS BYLAW,

WHEREAS, COUNCIL DEEMS IT NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE RESTRICTION AND PLACEMENT OF PORTABLE SIGNS WITHIN THE TOWN OF INNISFAIL AND IMPOSE A SPECIFIED PENALTY FOR ANY INFRACTION THEREOF,

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF INNISFAIL, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA ENACTS A BYLAW REFERRED TO AS THE "PORTABLE SIGN BYLAW".

SECTION 1: DEFINITION

A PORTABLE SIGN IS A SIGN WHICH IS NOT IN A PERMANENTLY INSTALLED OR AFFIXED POSITION, AND SHALL BE NO HIGHER THAN 2M (7 FT) ABOVE GRADE OR LARGER THAN 3 M2 (32 FT2).

SECTION 2: REGULATIONS

NO PERSON, PROPRIETOR, ORGANIZATION, OR OWNER OF A BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENT SHALL:

- A) PLACE A PORTABLE SIGN AS TO OBSTRUCT THE VIEW OF OR BE LIABLE TO BE CONFUSED WITH ANY AUTHORIZED TRAFFIC SIGN, SIGNAL OR DEVICE, OR OTHERWISE POSE A POTENTIAL HAZARD TO PEDESTRIAN OR MOTORING TRAFFIC.
- B) PLACE OR ALLOW THE PLACEMENT OF A SIGN NOT BEING MAINTAINED IN A PROPER STATE OF REPAIR.
- C) ERECT OR PERMIT THE PLACEMENT OF A PORTABLE SIGN UNLESS IT BE SITUATED WHOLLY UPON THE SITE OF THE BUSINESS OF LAND USE TO WHICH THE ADVERTISING OF THE SIGN REFERS AND ONLY ONE PORTABLE SIGN SHALL BE PLACED IN SUCH PARCEL OF LAND AT ANY ONE TIME.
- D) PLACE A PORTABLE SIGN ON ANY TOWN OWNED PROPERTY WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OR CONSENT OF THE CAO OR HIS DELEGATE, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF SIGNS USED FOR ADVERTISING COMMUNITY OR NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION EVENTS AND ANY SUCH PERSON OR ORGANIZATION POSTING SUCH SIGNS SHALL REMOVE SAME WITHIN 24 HOURS OF THE CONCLUSION OF SUCH EVENT.

SECTION 3: PENALTIES

ANY PERSON, PROPRIETOR, ORGANIZATION OR BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENT WHO CONTRAVENES ANY PROVISION OF THIS BYLAW IS GUILTY OF AN OFFENCE AND IS LIABLE TO A VOLUNTARY SPECIFIED PENALTY OF \$100.00 FOR THE FIRST OFFENCE AND \$300.00 FOR ANY SUBSEQUENT OFFENCE AND IN DEFAULT 5 TO 30 DAYS IMPRISONMENT OR JUDGMENT IN THE CASE OF A BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENT OR ORGANIZATION.

SECTION 4: ENFORCEMENT

EVERY PEACE OFFICER OR DEVELOPMENT OFFICER IS HEREBY CHARGED WITH THE DUTY OF ENFORCING THE PROVISIONS OF THIS BYLAW.

SECTION 5: REPEAL

BYLAW 1368 IS HEREBY REPEALED BY THE PASSAGE OF THIS BYLAW.

SECTION 6: COMMENCEMENT OF LAW

THIS BYLAW SHALL COME INTO FULL FORCE AND EFFECT ON THE 24TH DAY OF JANUARY, 2000.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 24TH DAY OF JANUARY, 2000.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 24TH DAY OF JANUARY, 2000.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 24TH DAY OF JANUARY, 2000 AND FINALLY PASSED.
